Additional Preservation & Public Trails: 71% Open Space ERIA CITY HALL Honoring the local legacy of preservation and coastal agriculture, the nature-based Carpinteria Farm Preserve 8% & Bungalows permanently protects nearly 14 acres of additional open space overseen by a local third-party conservation group. This increases the total Carpinteria Bluffs preserve area by 13% for a total of 87 acres. Our plan will protect public access to 10.5 acres along with 3 acres of preserved farmland for 2 acre farm regenerative farming at no cost to the community. Permanent Publi Open Space 3 acres of Moreover, 41 new affordable housing units nestled alongside a 99-room bungalow-style retreat are also planned on this privately owned parcel zoned for housing and commercial development. A 99-room bungalow-style retreat, nestled alongside the newly preserved open space and farmland, will be designed to reflect Carpinteria's natural beauty and coastal agricultural heritage. Bungalows will be woven into the land to protect the natural views and surrounding environment and crafted with sustainable materials. Locally sourced goods and services will celebrate Carpinteria's small businesses and character while supporting local artisans and makers.
